Group A: "Multi Blaze"

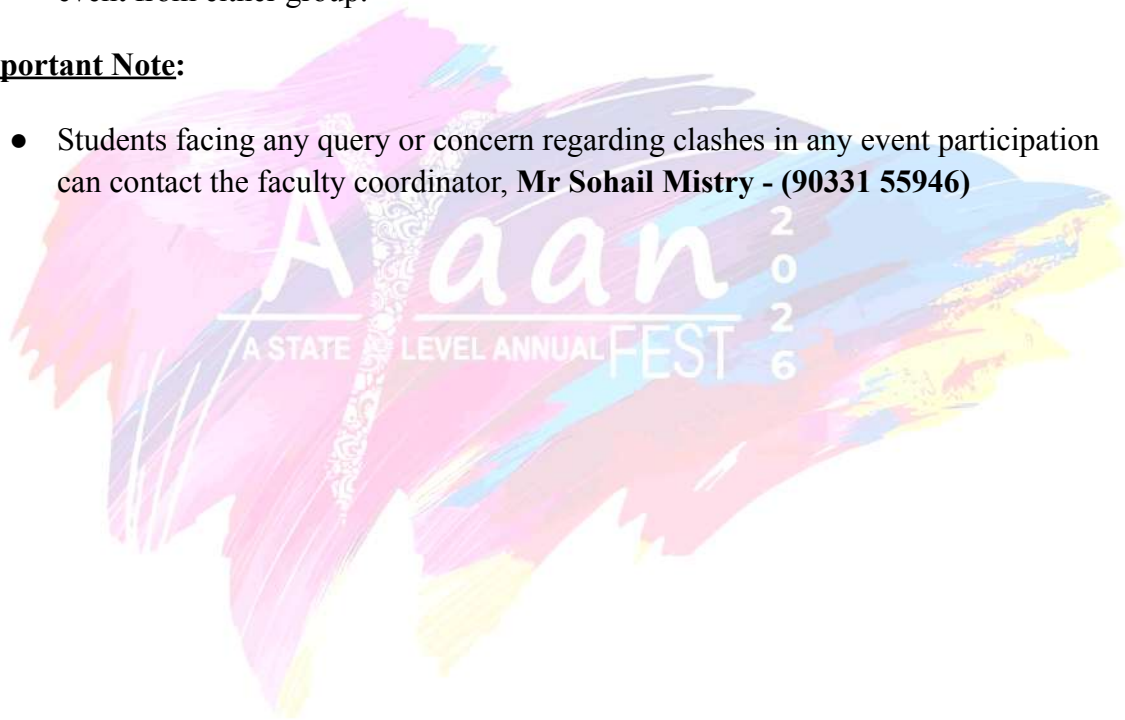
- Participants in Multi Blaze can compete in up to three events within this group.
- For example, if a participant chooses Talent Hunt (Solo), they are eligible to participate in two more events from the Multi Blaze list.

Group B: "Uni Spark"

- Participants in Uni Spark can only compete in any one and only one event.
- For example, if a participant selects Box Cricket, they cannot participate in any other event from either group.

Box Cricket

“Swing, Spin, and Score Big Wins”

Experience the thrill of a high-octane, knockout-style cricket tournament played in a confined "box" setting. This event emphasises strategic play, including mandatory female participation and the high-stakes super ball.

- Each college/department can send up to **two entries**, each entry with **seven students per entry (including two females mandatory)**.
- All matches will be played on a knockout basis.
- One match will be of six overs, where one bowler is allowed to bowl only one over.
- First over must be bowled and played by a female player from both teams.
- When a female player comes to bat, the bowling must be done by a female player only.
- No declaration allowed except retired hurt.
- Hit wicket out will cost minus six runs as a penalty.
- The last ball of each over will be a super ball. (Elaboration of Super Ball will be declared on the spot)
- Description of extra runs (for e.g. wide, no ball) will be given on the spot.
- There will be no free hit for “No ball.”
- The Umpire's decision will be considered the final decision.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees: ₹ 300 Per Student**

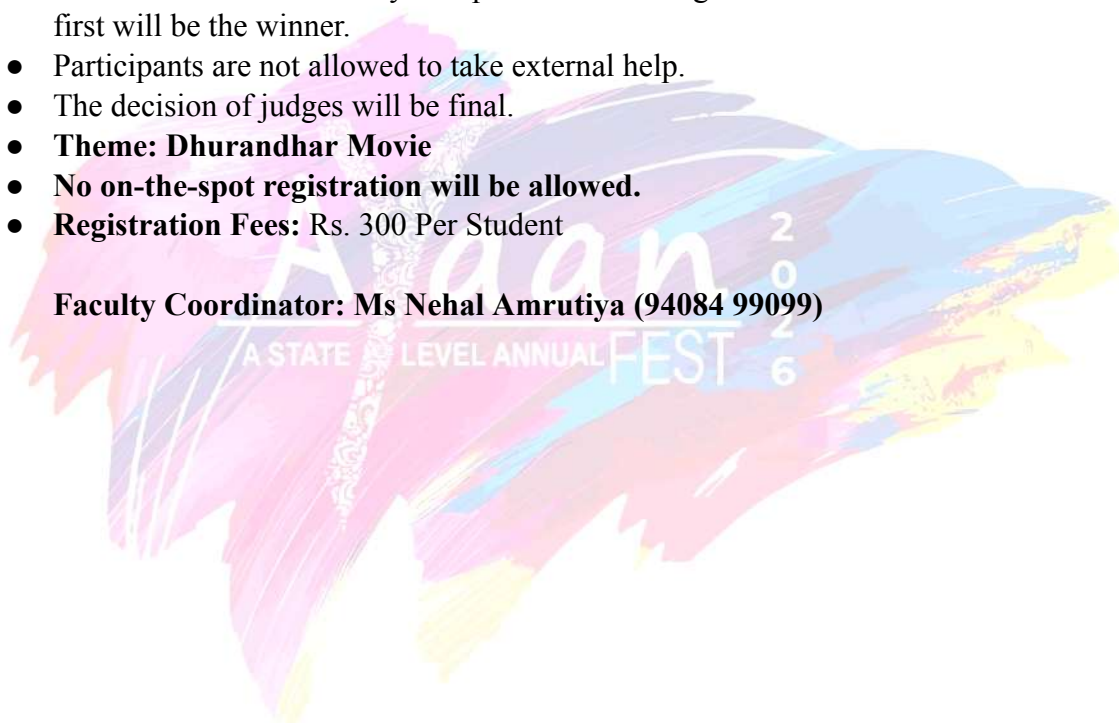
Scavenger Hunt

- This hunt is a mixture of different skilful tasks that require creativity, critical thinking, and teamwork to gather specific items.
- The hunt will consist of multiple rounds, each round having different fun twists that align with the secret missions.
- The team that successfully completes all challenges and reaches the final destination first will be the winner.
- Participants are not allowed to take external help.
- The decision of judges will be final.
- **Theme: Dhurandhar Movie**

Take the stage to express your unique individuality through singing, dancing, acting, magic, or comedy. This solo platform focuses on originality, confidence, and the ability to inspire and engage a live audience.

- Each college/department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of a **single student** will be allowed.
- **Categories Allowed:** Singing, Dancing, Acting, Mimicry, Stand-up Comedy, Instrumental, Magic, Mono-Act, etc.
- Performance duration: **Minimum:** 3 minutes and **Maximum:** 7 minutes
- A maximum of **5 minutes** will be given for stage preparation (if required).
- A simple mic, sound system, and LED screen will be provided.
- Background music must be submitted **in a pen drive** before the event.
- No vulgar, offensive, or inappropriate content is allowed.
- Use of materials like water, fire, oil, or colours is **strictly prohibited**.
- Participants must carry their **own instruments/props**.
- **Judgment criteria:** Talent & originality, Confidence & expression, Audience engagement
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees:** ₹ 300 Per Student

Rhythm Roots -A Folk Dance Competition

“Culture. Rhythm. Expression.”

Celebrate India’s rich heritage through traditional folk or tribal dance forms. This group event emphasises cultural authenticity, synchronisation, and energetic formations set to traditional rhythmic music.

- Each college/department can send up to **one entry**. Each entry of a **minimum eight and a maximum twelve students** will be allowed.
- Only **Indian Folk/Tribal dance forms** are permitted.
- Classical /Fusion dance forms are **not allowed** in this category.
- It must be a folk song, and no film songs will be allowed
- Duration of performance: **Minimum:** 8 minutes and **Maximum:** 10 minutes
- A maximum of **5 minutes** will be provided for stage setup.
- Recorded music is allowed and must be submitted before the event starts.
- Teams must arrange their **own costumes and props**.
- Props should be safe and must not damage the stage.
- **Judgment criteria:** Rhythm & synchronization, Costumes & formations, Energy & overall presentation
- The decision of judges will be final.
- **No on-the-spot registration.**
- **Registration Fee:** ₹300 per student.

Dramatic-A Theatrical Competition

“The world is a stage – Own Yours”

Bring stories to life in this versatile acting competition covering drama, mime, skits, and street plays. Participants are judged on their theatrical impact, stagecraft, and the ability to deliver a powerful message

- Each college/department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of a **minimum three students** will be allowed.
- Participants can showcase any of their acting talents, such as **drama, mime, skit, street play**, etc., but are restricted strictly to **acting only**.
- Duration of performance: **Minimum: 5 minutes** and **Maximum: 15 minutes**
- A maximum of five minutes of time will be given for stage setup/preparation.
- Simple mic, sound systems, LED display will be provided; no other special service/facility will be provided.
- Sounds and Songs should be carried in a pen drive only and should be submitted before the event starts. One Accompanist will be allowed to handle sounds or backstage announcements, but shall not appear on stage.
- Languages permitted: English / Hindi / Gujarati. (Script must be submitted at the registration desk.)
- No vulgar or offensive content will be tolerated, and the performance will be discontinued/ disqualified immediately.
- No other material having the potential of spoiling the stage, such as oil, water, or colour, would be permitted.
- Participants will have to carry their property with them; no property will be provided.
- **Judgment Criteria:** Theatrical Impact, Acting Quality, Stage Craft, Coordination, Overall Message.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees: ₹ 300 Per Student**

Walk the ramp in a display of style and high-fashion "beyond the frame". Participants are challenged to showcase their own creative costumes and accessories with confidence, poise, and professional ramp presence.

- Each College/Department can send up to **ten entries**. Each entry of a **single student** will be allowed..
- Music and theme will be shared 72 hours before on the website.
- Participants must arrange their **own costumes, footwear, and accessories**.
- Purchased, rented, or professionally designed costumes are permitted.
- Props are allowed **only if approved in advance** and should not damage the stage.
- Each participant will get **1–2 minutes** on the ramp. The formation will be provided 1 hour before the event.
- Participants are responsible for their **personal belongings**.
- **Judgment Criteria:** Theatrical Impact, Acting Quality, Stage Craft, Coordination, Overall Message.
- The decision of judges will be **final and binding**.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees:** ₹ 300 Per Student

- The theme of competition will be provided on the spot.
- Judgment will be based on submitted photographs.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**

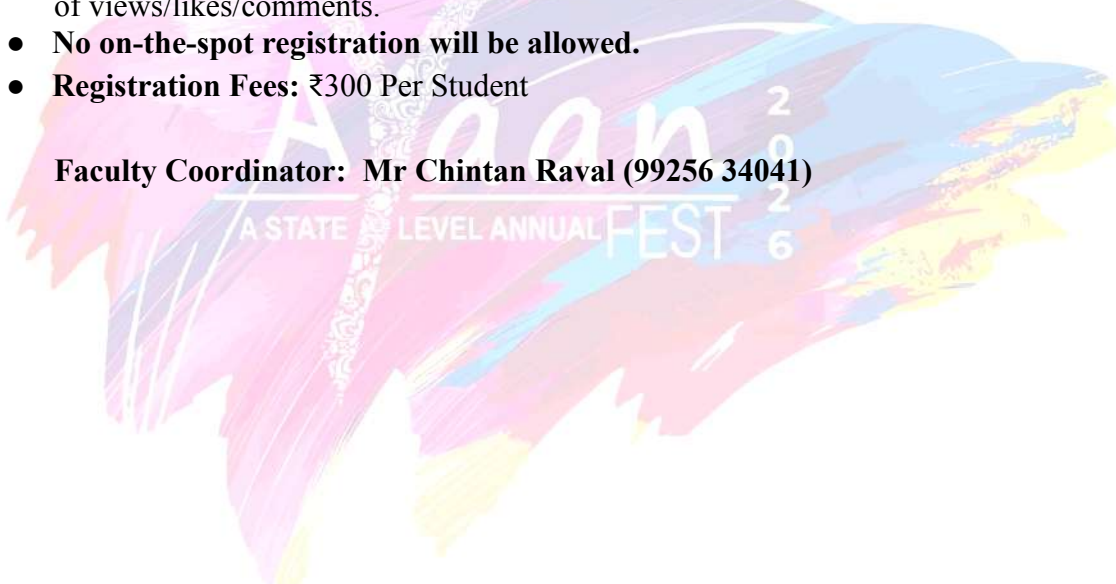
ViReel

- Each College/Department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry **minimum one and a maximum four** will be allowed.
- Solo and group reels will be treated equally, and common winners will be announced.
- Participants will be given a trending transition style that must be integrated into the final reel.
- The theme, Number of rounds, terms and conditions for the event will be declared on the spot.
- Participants have to make the REEL within the campus itself.
- The duration of the reel will be 30 seconds.
- Participants must post a reel on their timeline and add **@sanskarinst** as a collaborator.
- **Judgment Criteria:** Creativity, expressions, presentation and number of views/likes/comments.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**

The creator's cut- A product Review Competition

"Unbox. Review. Influence."

Step into the role of a digital influencer by producing a high-quality, YouTube-style review of a "mystery product". This on-site production challenge tests your videography, editing, and persuasive presentation skills

- Each College/Department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of a **minimum one student and a maximum three students** will be allowed.

General Guidelines

- Team Size: Up to 3 members — one Presenter, one Videographer, and one Editor.
- Format: On-site Video Production.
- Objective: To create a high-quality, engaging YouTube-style product review for a randomly assigned product.
- Equipment: Participants must use their own smartphones/cameras and editing software

The Event Workflow

- Each team will get a "Mystery product".
- Products could include: A vintage gadget, a quirky lifestyle item, a snack brand, or even a mystery "utility" tool.
- The Shoot: Teams can use the college campus as their "studio." They are encouraged to find aesthetic backgrounds or "real-world" testing spots.
- Style: The video should follow a YouTube format
- The final cut has to be submitted.

Video Requirements

- Duration: Minimum 3 minutes; Maximum 5 minutes.
- Format: 1080p (MP4/MOV). 16:9 Aspect Ratio (Horizontal).
- Mandatory Elements:
 - A catchy "Thumbnail" (to be submitted as a JPEG).
 - An "Intro Hook" (first 10 seconds).
 - A "Call to Action" (e.g., "Like, Share, and Subscribe!")
- **Judgement Criteria:** Product inside, Cinematography, Editing skills, Entertainment value and the thumbnail.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees:** ₹ 300 per Student

In-'sta'-Fluencer-A Digital Content Creation Competition

“Create. Connect. Influence.”

Visit a real-world organisation to shoot an impactful 60-second professional reel. This competition emphasises conceptual clarity, production quality, and the strategic use of calls-to-action to connect with a digital audience.

- Each College/Department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of **three students** will be allowed.
- Participants are supposed to visit a predefined business/organisation to shoot a 60-second reel.
- Name and Address of the business/organisation will be provided on the spot.
- Participants will have to submit their responses within a fixed time limit declared on the spot.
- Participants must consider the following rules before final submission:
 - **Format:** Vertical (9:16 aspect ratio), High Definition (1080p recommended).
 - **Audio:** Participants must use either original audio, trending audio from the Instagram Library, or royalty-free music.
 - **Originality:** All footage must be shot specifically for this competition. Use of stock footage is strictly prohibited.
 - **CTA:** The Reel must have a clear **Call to Action (CTA)**.
- **Required Hashtags:** Use the official event hashtags: #Ayaan2026 #SMIT #Vocal4Local
- Participants are free to use tools/gadgets of their choice for shooting and editing.
- Participants must post a reel on their timeline and add @sanskarinst as a collaborator.
- The judge's decision will be final.
- **Judgement Criteria:** Creativity, Clarity of concept, Production Quality, Engagement.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**

Ludo Legends – Big Board Ludo

“Roll, Move, Win, Repeat”

Relive the classic board game on a grander scale with competitive twists. Teams must roll, move, and strategise their way to victory while strictly following standard and event-specific policies

- Each College/Department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of **five students** will be allowed.
- Team members cannot be changed once the event has started.
- The game will follow standard Ludo rules, along with certain event-specific twists explained by the referee before the match.
- The game will proceed in a clockwise direction.
- The Roll and Move policy will be strictly followed.
- Elimination rounds may be conducted depending on the number of participating teams.
- The decision regarding elimination rounds will be taken by the referee/organising committee.
- Any form of misconduct, misbehaviour, or cheating will result in immediate disqualification.
- The referee’s decision will be final and binding.
- No objections or arguments against the referee’s decision will be entertained.
- The organising committee reserves the right to modify or amend the rules, if necessary.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**

The Mic Master-An Oratorical Competition

“Your words, your stage”

Harness the power of the spoken word through prepared speeches and impromptu "mystery" topics. Speakers are evaluated on their spontaneity, wit, delivery, and ability to think critically under pressure.

- Each College/Department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of **one student** will be allowed.
- The event will be a speech-based competition. (There will be 2 Rounds)
- Participants can use Gujarati, Hindi or English for their speech.
- Topics for speeches will be provided on the website 72 hours before the event.
- Participants will be judged on content, delivery, clarity & pronunciation, confidence and stage presence.
- If required, elimination rounds will be conducted to ensure a fair and competitive Environment after Round 1.
- The decision of the judges and the event management team will be final and binding.

Round 1: The Orator

- **Topic Release:** The topic will be uploaded to the official website 72 hours before the event.
- **Speech Duration:** 3 to 4 minutes.
- **Elimination:** Top scorers from Round 1 will proceed to Round 2
- **Rules:**
 - **Time Cues:** A warning bell will ring in 3 minutes. A final bell will ring at 4 minutes, after which the participant must conclude within 10 seconds.
 - **Penalties:** Marks will be deducted for speeches under 3 minutes or significantly over 4 minutes.
 - **Aids:** No digital aids (PPTs) are allowed. No Paper cue cards are permitted for reference

Round 2: The Impromptu Flash

- **Mechanism:** Participants will select a "mystery chit" that contains a topic, object, or abstract idea.
- **Preparation:** 2 minutes (on-the-spot).
- **Speech Duration:** 60 to 90 seconds.
- **Rules:**
 - The speaker must incorporate the specific word/topic from the chit into their speech.
 - The clock starts as soon as the participant begins speaking.
 - Evaluation: This round emphasises spontaneity, wit, and the ability to think critically under pressure.
- **Judgement Criteria:** Content, Dictation, Delivery, Structure and Timekeeping.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees:** ₹ 300 per Student

Breaking Now – A News Reporting Competition

“Ink It Print It Live It”

Step into the shoes of a journalist to report on the latest sports, entertainment, or market news. This event tests your ability to present unbiased, creative news reports with professional clarity and confidence

- Each College/Department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of **one student** will be allowed.
- Each participant will have to present news based on the last one week from the date of AYAAN.
- There should be a headline for each news.
- News presentations may cover topics from Entertainment and Sports, Technology and business.
- The minimum duration of news should be 3 minutes and the maximum duration will be 7 minutes.
- The content of the news should not be biased.
- Participants have to submit background images (JPG)/PPT/Video.
- **Judgment criteria:** Content of news, Confidence level of the participant, Clarity in explanation along with background & Creativity of presentation.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees:** ₹ 300 per Student

AI Pitcher – A Business Innovation event

“Your idea AI’s Power”

Identify real-world business problems and design innovative AI-based solutions. Teams must use AI tools to create logos, prediction models, and pitches that demonstrate technical applicability and business practicality

- Each College/Department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of **three students** will be allowed.
- Each team will be provided with a computer and internet facility (in case of non-availability of the participant’s laptop or internet).
- To test participants’ ability to identify business problems, design AI-based solutions, and think quickly under real-world business situations.
- Create and pitch an AI-based business solution for a given problem.
- Participants have to complete round one in a maximum of 1 hour and 30 minutes.
- **Pitch Must Include:**
 - Problem description
 - Target customers
 - AI solution (how AI is used)
 - Business benefit/revenue idea
 - Predictions
 - AI logo creation and explanation
 - Short solution video
- It is mandatory to have screenshots of all prompts.
- Participants are allowed to use any AI tools.
- **Judgment Criteria:** Problem Understanding, AI applicability, Business Practicality, Creativity & amp; clarity.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees:** ₹ 300 per Student

- Each College/Department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of **one student** will be allowed.
- Each participant is allowed to be accompanied by only one person. No other accompanying persons, friends, or assistants will be allowed inside the competition area.
- Nail extensions are allowed; however, pre-designed or pre-painted nails/extensions are strictly not allowed.
- The theme will be given on the spot, and participants must strictly follow the given theme.
- The total time limit for the competition is 2.5 hours (150 minutes).
- Materials: Participants must bring their own nail art materials and tools. Products from any companies/brands are permitted.
- **Judging Criteria:** Theme relevance, Skill & technique, Neatness & finishing, Colour combinations, Overall presentation
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees:** ₹300 Per Student

Flavour Fest – A Cooking Competition

“Serve the extraordinary”

Prepare extraordinary culinary delights in a flame-free environment. This competition challenges participants to create innovative, hygienic, and tasty vegetarian starters or chaats without the use of electric appliances

- Each College/Department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of a **maximum of two students** will be allowed.
- The competition will be for flameless cooking.
- No electric appliances will be allowed to be used. No raw material, stove or gas will be provided.
- No external accompaniment or outsider helper is allowed
- Each participant will be provided with a workstation for chart or starter preparation.
- The items to be prepared for the competition are Charts and starters.
- The participants must leave the space clean after the time of competition is over.
- The dish should be vegetarian only.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
- **Judgement criteria:** Taste, Hygiene, Presentation, Explanation of dish and Innovativeness.
- **No on-the-spot registration will be allowed.**
- **Registration Fees:** ₹ 300 Per Student

Mind-Maze – Quiz Competition

“Battle of minds”

Engage in an intellectual "battle of minds" across multiple rounds, including audio-visual and buzzer rounds. Test your knowledge in everything from quantitative aptitude to current affairs

- Each college/department can send up to **two entries**. Each entry of a **minimum one student and a maximum three students** will be allowed.
- This event will consist of multiple rounds.

General Guidelines

- Eligibility: Open to all participants with a passion for knowledge.
- Team Composition: Teams of 2–3 members (or individual participation, depending on event format).
- Scoring: Points accumulate across rounds, creativity and quick responses.
- Conduct: Teams must maintain decorum; use of unfair means (phones, notes) leads to disqualification.
- Type of Questions: Questions could be asked from a mixture of Reasoning, Quantitative aptitude, English, Basic knowledge of computer, current affairs (India Level).

Round 1: Elimination Round:

Theme: “Fuel the Mind, Spark the Game.”

- Format: Printed Questions with multiple options.
- Number of Questions: 30 MCQs.[+2 Tie Breaking questions, if required]
- Time Limit: 10 Minutes.
- Scoring: +1 for correct, no negative marking.
- Purpose: Elimination round to filter out the less potential teams.

Round 2: Audio Visual Round:

Theme: “Knowledge through Images & Imagination.”

- Image-Based Questions: Identify monuments, artworks, scientific diagrams, personalities, or maps.
- Audio-Based Questions: Recognise voices, speeches, musical pieces, or sound effects.
